Dear Parent or Guardian,

Would you like your son or daughter to build their self-confidence and learn to be a responsible leader who places integrity first, serves their community and strives for excellence in all endeavors? If so, JROTC may be the perfect program for your son or daughter to sign up for next year at GBHS. JROTC teaches leadership, character development, physical fitness, and Aerospace Science. Our program is a character building experience that all motivated students can benefit from.

There is **no military commitment** for signing up for JROTC. In fact, there is no incentive for me or MSgt Garcia to sign students up for the military. The Air Force pays for this program to give back to local communities and to build good citizens for our great nation. If, however, your student does want to go into the military via a service academy or collegiate ROTC, we will put them in direct contact with an admissions official which allows them to conduct interviews for both **ROTC scholarships** and **service academy appointments**. We also have fantastic relationships with recruiters from all service branches and work with them regularly for classroom and community engagement events. Additionally, **high school JROTC students are eligible to enlist in all branches of the military (Navy, Army, AF, or Marines) at a higher salary due to their additional leadership and service experiences.**

We have an outstanding marksmanship program, drill teams, honor guard, saber exhibition team, and a cyber security team to name a few. Students will benefit from participating in our teams through extensive teamwork, communication, time management and accountability. Teams do meet before and after school in order to sharpen their skills and to be competition ready. Also, members of AFJROTC are required to wear a uniform once a week (provided by the JROTC program). Accommodations will be made to help members of the band, clubs, and sports teams so that they can participate in more than one program at GBHS...in fact, we encourage our students to be involved in other extracurricular activities outside of JROTC.

If you believe your student could benefit from being a part of our winning team, then sign up your student for JROTC next year at Gulf Breeze High School.
