

## DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION

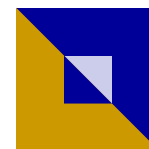
Gulf Breeze, Florida is a suburban community that includes approximately 25,000 people. Located at the tip of a 25 mile long, 3/4 mile wide peninsula, surrounded by Pensacola Bay and Santa Rosa Sound and one mile from the Gulf of Mexico, Gulf Breeze offers a lifestyle with recreational time focused on beach and water related activities. Parents are predominantly white-collar professionals who commute across a three mile bridge to Pensacola, Florida, (metropolitan area 250,000) and plan for their children to be college graduates and pursue similar lifestyles. Strongly supported by military bases, both Navy and Air Force, the school has many transfer students from all parts of the country, as well as military families who have chosen to retire here.

## SCHOOL INFORMATION

With a school population of approximately 2000 students, grades 9-12. Gulf Breeze High School employs a principal, three assistant principals, eighty-six teachers, five counselors and twenty-two education support personnel. Each year the curriculum is evaluated to provide an optimal number of Honors, Advanced, Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment courses for the college bound students as well as career academies whose goal is to prepare our students for the work-force with industry certifications.

Ninety percent of Gulf Breeze High School graduates attend college, with approximately seventy percent going directly to four year institutions. Approximately thirteen percent of our graduates select out of state colleges, including state universities and highly selective private schools.
