\*\*As registration begins and courses begin to reach capacity, students may not be able to register for their first choice course. However, they may elect to take those courses

online through a virtual provider like SRVS or FLVS as an alternative. Students are encouraged to register early to ensure that they are able to select all of the courses that they qualify for and are interested in taking next year.

	English I Honors	Language Arts: 95; Advanced Language Arts: 85 <b>Summer reading and assignment REQUIRED.</b>
	Algebra I	Pre-Algebra: 70; Students who do not show proficiency on the 8 <sup>th</sup> grade Math FSA and/or in the Pre-Algebra class may be placed in Algebra 1A. Must pass the End of Course Exam to graduate and the EOC will count as 30% of the final grade.
	Geometry	Algebra I: 70. The End of Course Exam will count as 30% of the final grade.
	Geometry Honors	Algebra I Honors: 90. Algebra 1: 95; The End of Course Exam will count as 30% of the final grade. <b>Summer assignments are required.</b>
	Algebra II	Geometry Honors: 89 or below.
	Algebra II Honors	Algebra I Honors: 90 and Geometry Honors: 90. <b>Summer assignments are required.</b>
	Integrated Science	\$10 lab fee for all science courses
	Biology I Honors	Advanced Science: 90; Regular Science: 95. The EOC will count as 30% of the final grade. \$10 lab fee for all science courses. <b>Summer assignments are required.</b>

Virtual Lab	Students will be enrolled in an SRVS or FLVS course and credit will be awarded upon completion of the online course.
<b>Application or IEP Required Electives</b> - When registering, you will see a prompt asking if you will be taking a class that requires <i>Special Permission</i> . These courses are listed below. Your counselor will assign you to the appropriate class after sponsor/teacher approval is given. Applications have different due dates. Journalism 1	Application & approval of yearbook sponsor. This will prepare students to contribute to yearbook.
TV Production 1	Application & approval of ITV teacher. This will count as a fine art credit. \$10 fee.
Debate 1	Application, try-outs & approval of Debate sponsor. Counts for fine art credit.
Medical Skills & Services	Application for Academy for Health & Medical Professions.
Learning Strategies-IEP	<i>Must have an active IEP.</i>
Career Preparation-IEP	<i>Must have an active IEP.</i>
Intensive Language Arts	Students who do not show proficiency on the 8 <sup>th</sup> grade FSA ELA test may be placed in an Intensive Language Arts in addition to their regular classes.
