AP Capstone Student Application, 2022-2023

AP Capstone provides the opportunity for students to develop critical thinking, research, and communication skills and culminates with an independent research project. Students accepted into the program will complete two AP courses, AP Seminar and AP Research, along with any four other AP courses. These two AP courses are aligned with practices and skills that research has identified as critical to university and career success. Students who earn scores of 3 or higher in both of the AP Capstone courses and on four additional AP Exams of their choosing will receive the AP Capstone Diploma. Students who earn scores of 3 or higher in both of the AP Capstone program courses but not on the four additional AP Exams will receive the AP Capstone Certificate, signifying successful completion of those courses.

Because the AP Capstone program is reserved for a limited number of students, it is essential we choose students who are capable of completing the program requirements in addition to any other commitments. To be successful in this program, you must have a strong work ethic and be able to meet deadlines and work in a team. You will be required to make frequent presentations and participate regularly in class discussions. Students must be able to work independently to meet goals and deadlines. **There will be a summer work assignment.**

- English I/II Honors: 85
