



Application for Gulf Breeze Rotary Club Scholarship – 2021

Eligibility Requirements for Rotary Club Scholarships

- Applicants must be a graduating senior at Gulf Breeze High School with a 2.9 Grade Point Average or better.
 - applicants will be assessed by a combination of factors including GPA, their essay, financial need, leadership, and community involvement.
- Applications must be completed in full and accompanied by the following **mandatory** documents:
 - a transcript of all high school grades
 - official SAT and/or ACT scores as attachments
 - a short essay about your goals and reasons for applying
 - a copy of the applicant's résumé
 - copies of income tax returns of parents/guardians
- Applicants are solely responsible for submitting all forms and other information required for consideration by the scholarship selection committee.

- Scholarship funds will be disbursed to recipients upon receipt of appropriate documentation that the individual is enrolled as a full time student in an accredited college, university, junior college, or vocational training facility.
- Scholarships must be used at the beginning of the academic year and used on a continuous basis thereafter without interruption in the case of multi-year scholarships.
- Completed applications must be returned to the guidance counselor's office no later than Thursday, February 26th, 2021.
- Gulf Breeze Rotarians' sons and daughters, grandchildren, and stepchildren are not eligible for these scholarships.
- Scholarships will be presented at the Gulf Breeze Rotary Club meeting which will be held at the Andrews Institute during the month of April 2021 (exact date TBD).

- grade transcript
- ACT/SAT scores
