What is ITV?

ITV/TV Production is a small learning community within the school in which students participate in producing the daily morning show. Students meet as a regular class first period, and they receive one fine arts credit per school year. Students are responsible for covering campus news events, sports, and other activities. The program is career oriented with a focus on broadcast journalism and film making careers. Students are required to hold a job position in the newsroom and to work in a team environment. There are jobs both in front of and behind the camera. The deadline to apply is the last day of school, but there are a limited number of students accepted to the program, so apply as soon as possible.

Requirements:

- Students may be entering 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grade.
- Applicants must fill out an application and schedule an appointment to visit our studio. Email Mrs. Reeves at Reevesc@santarosa.k12.fl.us, drop by the studio during first period, or see her in room 411.
- GBHS Students must have a reference from an English teacher. (See attached form).
- Students must have a minimum of a 3.00 unweighted GPA and must be seeking a standard high school diploma.
- Disciplinary records must reflect no more than a minimal number of minor occurrences and an acceptable attendance history.
- Upon acceptance, students must maintain a 3.0 GPA in TV Production. Failure to maintain acceptable attendance, good behavior, and the 3.0 GPA could result in withdrawal from the program.
- Students must follow the rules and guidelines of GBHS and ITV.
- Students are always expected to act professionally and to represent GBHS in a positive manner.
- There is an activity fee of \$10.00 payable to GBHS the first week of school. The funds will be used for equipment, supplies, and contest fees.
